### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to require that:		
2	(1) Certain proceeds of the agricultural loan revolving	[	
3	fund be deposited into a new department of agricult	ure	
4	staffing special fund; and		
5	(2) These proceeds be expended for department personnel	•	
6	salary and fringe benefit costs.		
7	SECTION 2. Chapter 141, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
8	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
9	and to read as follows:		
10	" <u>§141-</u> Department of agriculture staffing special fur	ıd.	
11	(a) There is established within the treasury of the State the	<u>le</u>	
12	department of agriculture staffing special fund.		
13	(b) Deposits into the special fund pursuant to section		
14	155-14(b) shall be made by the director of finance.		
15	Any interest earned on moneys deposited into the special	:	
16	fund shall be the realization of the special fund.

1	(c) Expenditures from the special fund shall be made to			
2	pay the salary and fringe benefits costs of department personnel			
3	whose positions, on June 30, 2009, were funded from the general			
4	fund or the agricultural loan reserve fund.			
5	(d) Any unexpended moneys in the special fund on June 30,			
6	2015, shall be transferred by the director of finance to the			
7	agricultural loan revolving fund on July 1, 2015."			
8	SECTION 3. Section 155-14, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is			
9	amended to read as follows:			
10	"§155-14 Funds; application of payments. (a) There is			
11	created a special fund to be known as the agricultural loan			
12	revolving fund, from which moneys shall be loaned by the			
13	department of agriculture under this chapter. [ <del>The department,</del>			
14	by its board of agriculture, may transfer moneys from the			
15	agricultural loan revolving fund to the aquaculture loan			
16	revolving fund, from which moneys shall be disbursed by the			
17	department pursuant to chapter 219, and may transfer moneys from			
18	that revolving fund to the agricultural loan revolving fund for			
19	disbursement pursuant to this chapter; provided that:			
20	(1) The amount of moneys transferred shall not exceed			
21	\$1,000,000 for-each-revolving-fund-within-the calendar

Before the convening of the Regular Session of 13 14 2012, the department of agriculture shall submit to the 15 legislature a report identifying the amount of money deposited 16 into the department of agriculture staffing special fund from 17 July 1, 2010, until December 31, 2011, pursuant to this Act, the amount of money expended or encumbered between those dates, and 18 19 the projected amount to be deposited into the special fund from 20 January 1, 2012, until June 30, 2012. #### Report Title: Department of Agricultural Staffing Special Fund; Creation

#### Description:

Requires the deposit of a portion of the agricultural loan repayments into a new department of agriculture staffing special fund. Requires moneys in the special fund to be expended on department personnel salary and fringe benefit costs that were previously paid from the general fund. Requires report to the legislature. Takes effect on 7/1/2010 and sunsets on 6/30/2015.
