10		of the windshield farthest removed from the driver or

14	(4)	Rear trunk lid handle or hinges;
15	(5)	Window wipers and window wiper motors;
16	(6)	Transparent sun screening film materials which are
17		installed, affixed, or applied along the top edge of
18		the windshield so long as such materials do not

2		encroach upon the AS-1 portion of the windshield as

8		margin of the windshield;
9	(7)	Sun screening devices for front side wing vents and
10		windows which, when used in conjunction with the
11		glazing material have a light transmittance of no less
12		than thirty-five per cent plus or minus six per cent;
13	(8)	Sun screening devices for side windows necessary for
14		driving visibility which are to the rear of the driver
15		and for rear windows necessary for driving visibility
16		which, when used in conjunction with the glazing
17		material, have a light transmittance of no less than
18		thirty-five per cent plus or minus six per cent;
19	(9)	Side windows which are to the rear of the driver and
20		rear windows on vans, minivans, trucks, or buses;
21		provided that the vehicles are equipped with rearview
22		mirrors on both sides;
