BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

14	(4)	Rear trunk lid handle or hinges;
15	(5)	Window wipers and window wiper motors;
16	(6)	Transparent sun screening film materials [which] <u>that</u>
17		are installed, affixed, or applied [along the top edge
18		of] to any portion of the windshield so long as [such]

the materials [do not encroach upon the AS-1 portion 1 2 of the windshield as provided by] when applied to the windshield meet the requirements of the Federal Motor 3 Vehicle Safety [Standards] Standard 205 [or no lower 4 than four inches below the top of the windshield, when 5 measured from the middle point of the bottom edge of 6 7 the top windshield moulding if no AS-1 markings can be found in the left or right upper margin of the 8 windshield]; 9 Sun screening devices for front side wing vents and 10 (7) windows [which,] that, when used in conjunction with 11 the glazing material, have a light transmittance of no 12 less than thirty-five per cent plus or minus six per 13 14 cent; Sun screening devices for side windows necessary for 15 (8) driving visibility [which] that are to the rear of the 16 17 driver and for rear windows necessary for driving visibility [which,] that, when used in conjunction 18 with the glazing material, have a light transmittance 19 of no less than thirty-five per cent plus or minus six 20 21 per cent;
