SECTION 1. Section 266-2.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the
4 department of transportation shall allow, on a space available
5 basis, a vessel with a use permit authorizing the vessel to moor
6 in Kewalo basin to moor in Honolulu harbor at no additional cost
7 and with no additional use permit required under the following
8 conditions:

9 (1) The manager of Kewalo basin prohibits entrance into
10 Kewalo basin because of inclement weather or ocean
11 conditions; provided that as soon as the manager of
12 Kewalo basin opens the entrance to vessels, the vessel
13 shall leave Honolulu harbor; or

14 (2) The owner or operator of a commercial fishing vessel 15 desires to sell the owner's or operator's catch of 16 fish to a business operating within Honolulu harbor or 17 otherwise conduct business within Honolulu harbor; 18 provided that the vessel shall not moor in Honolulu
