A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSFER OF STATE HIGHWAYS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the State's current 1 2 fiscal crisis necessitates an abolition of duplicative state and 3 county functions. The state department of transportation and 4 the department of public works of the county of Maui share overlapping functions for the maintenance of highways. 5 The 6 legislature further finds that counties are more economically 7 efficient at providing highway functions inasmuch as the highways are inherently a county function in Hawaii, which does 8 9 not have an interstate highway system similar to mainland 10 states.

11 The purpose of this Act is to establish a pilot project to:
12 (1) Provide for the transfer of all state highway
13 maintenance functions on Maui, Molokai, and Lanai to
14 the county of Maui; and
15 (2) Transfer applicable funding for the maintenance of
16 state highways in the county of Maui from the State to

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Maui county.

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1	SECTION 2	. Pilot project established. There is		
2	established a	pilot project to transfer all state highway		
3	, jurisdiction and functions relating to the maintenance of state			
4	highways located on Maui, Molokai, and Lanai to the county of			
5	Maui, and to t	ransfer applicable funding for the maintenance of		
6	state highways from the State to Maui county in accordance with			
7	this Act.			
8	SECTION 3	. Definitions. For purposes of this Act:		
9	"State hig	ghways" means every highway on Maui island,		
10	Molokai island, and Lanai island that is under the jurisdiction			
11	of the state department of transportation, highways division, as			
12	of July 1, 201	0, including but not limited to:		
13	(1) Maui	district:

Transfer of functions. No later than 1 SECTION 4. 2 January 1, 2011, the jurisdiction, functions, powers, duties, 3 and authority heretofore exercised by the state department of 4 transportation relating to the maintenance of state highways 5 located in the county of Maui shall be transferred to and 6 conferred upon the department of public works of the county of 7 Maui by this Act until this Act is repealed at which time the 8 jurisdiction, functions, powers, duties, and authority shall 9 revert to the state department of transportation.

10 The department of public works of the county of Maui shall 11 succeed to all of the rights and powers previously exercised, 12 and all the duties and obligations incurred by the state 13 department of transportation in the exercise of the functions, 14 powers, duties, and authority transferred, whether such 15 functions, powers, duties, and authority are mentioned in or 16 granted by law, contract, or other document.

All rules, policies, procedures, guidelines, and other material adopted or developed by the state department of transportation relating to the maintenance of state highways located in the county of Maui that are made applicable to the department of public works of the county of Maui shall remain in full force and effect, including during the duration of the HB2301 HD2 HMS 2010-2246

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pilot project established under this Act, except as provided under section 8. Effective July 1, , every reference to the state department of transportation highways division or the director of transportation shall be construed as a reference to the department of public works or the director of public works of the county of Maui, as appropriate.

7 All deeds, leases, contracts, loans, agreements, permits, or other documents executed or entered into by or on behalf of 8 9 the state department of transportation highways division pursuant to the provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, that 10 11 are made applicable to the department of public works of the 12 county of Maui shall remain in full force and effect, including 13 during the duration of the pilot project established under this 14 Act.

15 SECTION 5. Transfer of department functions, officers, and 16 employees. Concurrent with the transfer of jurisdiction over 17 the maintenance of state highways to the county of Maui, all 18 rights, powers, functions, and duties of the state department of 19 transportation with respect to the transfer of the maintenance 20 of state highways shall be transferred to the department of 21 public works of the County of Maui until this Act is repealed at

which time the rights, powers, functions, and duties shall
 revert to the state department of transportation.

All officers and employees whose functions are transferred by this Act shall be transferred with their functions and shall continue to perform their regular duties upon their transfer, subject to the state personnel laws and this Act, until this Act is repealed, at which time the officers and employees shall be transferred back to the state department of transportation.

9 No officer or employee of the State having tenure shall 10 suffer any loss of salary, seniority, prior service credit, 11 vacation, sick leave, or other employee benefit or privilege as 12 a consequence of this Act, and such officer or employee may be 13 transferred or appointed to a civil service position without the 14 necessity of examination; provided that:

15 (1) The officer or employee possesses the minimum
16 qualifications for the position to which transferred

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or appointed; and

18 (2) Subsequent changes in status may be made pursuant to19 applicable civil service and compensation laws.

20 An officer or employee of the State who does not have21 tenure and who may be transferred or appointed to a civil

22 service position as a consequence of this Act shall become a



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civil service employee without the loss of salary, seniority,
 prior service credit, vacation, sick leave, or other employee
 benefits or privileges and without the necessity of examination;
 provided that such officer or employee possesses the minimum
 qualifications for the position to which transferred or
 appointed.

If an office or position held by an officer or employee 7 8 having tenure is abolished, the officer or employee shall not 9 thereby be separated from public employment, but shall remain in 10 the employment of the State with the same pay and classification and shall be transferred to some other office or position for 11 12 which the officer or employee is eligible under the personnel 13 laws of the State as determined by the state director of 14 transportation or the governor.

15 SECTION 6. Transfer of records and appropriations. 16 Concurrent with the transfer of jurisdiction over the 17 maintenance of state highways to the county of Maui, all 18 appropriations, records, equipment, machines, files, supplies, contracts, books, papers, documents, maps, and other personal 19 20 property heretofore made, used, acquired, or held by the state department of transportation relating to the functions 21 22 transferred to the department of public works of the county of

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Maui shall be transferred with the functions to which they
 relate, until this Act is repealed, at which time the
 appropriations, records, equipment, machines, files, supplies,
 contracts, books, papers, documents, maps, and other personal
 property shall be transferred back to the state department of
 transportation.

7 SECTION 7. Federal funds, administration and transfer.
8 (a) The highways division, or similar administrative division,
9 of the state department of transportation shall continue to
10 receive, transfer, or expend federal funds for state highways
11 located in the county of Maui, including during the duration of
12 the pilot project established under this Act.

13 (b) Concurrent with the transfer of jurisdiction over the 14 maintenance of state highways to the county of Maui, the state director of transportation shall transfer to the county of Maui 15 16 all federal aid to the State that is to be used for highway 17 maintenance on state highways transferred to Maui county under 18 this Act. The state department of transportation shall do all 19 things necessary to ensure that federal aid to the State is transferred to Maui county as appropriate for the use by Maui 20 21 county for state highways transferred to Maui county under this

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Act, and that no federal funds are lost or jeopardized for this
 use.

3 (c) It is the intent of this Act not to jeopardize the 4 receipt of any federal aid nor to impair the obligation of the 5 State or Maui county, or any agency respectively thereof, to the 6 holders of any bond issued by the State or by any such agency, 7 and to the extent, and only to the extent, necessary to 8 effectuate this intent, the governor or mayor of Maui, as 9 applicable, may modify the strict provisions of this Act, but 10 shall promptly report any such modification with reasons 11 therefor to the legislature at its next session thereafter for 12 review by the legislature.

13 SECTION 8. Adoption of ordinances and rules. The county 14 council of Maui may adopt ordinances and the department of 15 public works of the county of Maui may adopt administrative 16 rules relating to state highways, as defined in section 3 of 17 this Act, for the period of time the pilot project is in 18 existence; provided that ordinances shall be deemed to be 19 supplemental to provisions of the Hawaii Revised Statutes, and 20 county administrative rules shall be deemed to supersede state administrative rules where a county rule is comprehensive so as 21 22 to be intended to be exclusive. In the absence of county HB2301 HD2 HMS 2010-2246

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administrative rules, state administrative rules shall remain in
 full force and effect.

SECTION 9. Transfer of mandated programs; funding. 3 4 Article VIII, section 5, of the Hawaii Constitution, relating to 5 state funding of mandated programs to the counties, shall be 6 deemed satisfied by the transfer of state appropriations and federal funds from the State to the county of Maui under this 7 8 Act; provided that the county of Maui may request the legislature to appropriate additional funds as necessary from 9 10 time to time to implement this Act.

11 SECTION 10. Reports to legislature. The state department 12 of transportation and the department of public works of the 13 county of Maui shall each report separately to the legislature 14 on the progress, problems, implementation, and other relevant 15 issues concerning the transfer of jurisdiction over the 16 maintenance of state highways to the county of Maui. The 17 reports shall be filed no later than twenty days prior to the 18 convening of the regular session immediately preceding the 19 repeal date of this Act.

20 SECTION 11. Reversion to State on sunset. On December 31,
21 2016, or at a later date as may be specified for a sunset
22 pursuant to amendment to this Act, the functions transferred by HB2301 HD2 HMS 2010-2246

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1 this Act to the department of public works of the county of Maui
2 shall revert back to the state department of transportation,
3 including transfer of officers and employees, records and
4 appropriations, and federal funds transfers, on the same terms
5 and conditions as specified in this Act for the transfer from
6 the state department of transportation to the department of
7 public works of the county of Maui.

8 SECTION 12. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020,9 and shall be repealed on December 31, 2016.
