#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PLANNED COMMUNITY ASSOCIATIONS.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 421J, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 3 and to read as follows: 4 "§421J-Flag poles. Notwithstanding any law to the 5 contrary, no member shall be prevented by any covenant, 6 declaration, bylaws, restriction, deed, lease, term, provision, 7 condition, codicil, contract, or similar binding agreement, 8 however worded, from erecting and using a flag pole for the 9 purpose of displaying the flag of the United States or of the 10 State on the premises of any detached single-family residential 11 dwelling or townhouse that the member owns; provided that the 12 board of directors may implement reasonable restrictions with 13 regard to flag poles, including but not limited to size and location, that do not prohibit the erection and use of flag 14 15 poles altogether." 16 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 17 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were

18 begun before its effective date.
