A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII SCHOOL OF TRAVEL INDUSTRY MANAGEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Pursuant to article X, section 6 of the Hawaii 2 Constitution, with respect to the University of Hawaii, the 3 legislature has the power to enact laws of statewide concern. 4 The legislature finds it a matter of statewide concern that the 5 school of travel industry management at the University of Hawaii at Manoa remain autonomous from the Schidler college of business 6 7 The autonomy of the school of travel industry administration. 8 management enables it to be the most efficient of the schools 9 and colleges that comprise the University of Hawaii at Manoa. 10 Such autonomy also enables the school to remain competitive with 11 its peer institutions around the nation and world.

12 The purpose of this Act is to statutorily establish a 13 school of travel industry management at the University of Hawaii 14 at Manoa that is separate and independent of any school or 15 college of business administration also established at the 16 university.

1 SECTION 2. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by adding a new subpart to part IV to be appropriately 3 designated and to read as follows: 4 11 . School of Travel Industry Management 5 §304A- School of travel industry management. There 6 shall be a school of travel industry management at the University of Hawaii at Manoa that shall be separate and 7 8 independent of any school or college of business administration 9 established at the university. The school shall be under the 10 direction of a dean or director, who shall be appointed by the 11 president of the university with the approval of the board of 12 regents; provided that the person appointed as dean or director 13 shall not simultaneously hold a post as dean or director of any 14 school or college of business administration established at the 15 university. The school shall offer courses of study as may be 16 deemed appropriate and confer degrees as may be authorized by 17 the board of regents." 18 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored. 19 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2112.
