A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The legislature finds that there is a lack of 1 SECTION 1. 2 hospitals and health centers in the southern portion of the 3 island of Hawaii, and residents of the area are particularly vulnerable in the event of a serious medical emergency. 4 The most efficient solution is to provide two emergency mobile 5 urgent care units to be stationed at the fire departments in the 6 7 communities of Ocean View and Volcano.

8 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the 9 department of health to develop a pilot program in cooperation 10 with emergency medical services, the fire departments, the 11 Hawaii health systems corporation, and the community clinics to 12 provide the people of the southern portion of the island of 13 Hawaii with increased access to appropriate emergency and urgent 14 medical care.

15 SECTION 2. (a) The department of health shall establish a 16 pilot program in cooperation with emergency medical services, 17 the fire departments, Hawaii health systems corporation, and 18 community clinics to provide additional emergency and urgent HB HMS 2009-1119

services in the Ocean View and Volcano communities on the island
of Hawaii.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of4 health for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
