#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TAXATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1. SECTION 1. The legislature finds that private sector 2 investment and development into a depressed or economically 3 deprived area in the State enhances and revitalizes that area 4 and its surrounding neighborhoods through stimulating growth in 5. the business, agricultural, or industrial segments of the 6 economy. The legislature also finds that the tax incentives 7 provided under the State's enterprise zones law are an existing 8 mechanism that encourages and spurs private sector investment in 9 those designated areas.

Senate Concurrent Resolution No. 132, S.D. 1 (2009), established a task force to determine the economic contributions of the construction industry in Hawaii. As directed in the concurrent resolution, the task force developed a series of proposals for state actions to preserve and create new jobs in the local construction industry. The intent of this measure is to implement one of the task force's proposals.

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1 encourage private sector investment to begin projects that will 2 lead to the construction, development, or rehabilitation of new 3 or existing buildings or structures in those designated 4 enterprise zones. 5 SECTION 2. Section 209E-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 6 amended as follows: 7 By adding two new definitions to read: 1. 8. ""Historic property" means a building or structure that is: 9 (1) Over fifty years old; and 10 (2) Listed on the national register of historic places or 11 the Hawaii register of historic places. 12 "Multi-family dwelling" means any building or structure for 13 sale, lease, or rent that provides shelter for more than two 14 dwellings." 15 2. By amending the definition of "eligible business activity" to read: 16 17 ""Eligible business activity" means the: 18 (1) Manufacture of tangible personal property, the wholesale sale of tangible personal property as 19 20 described in section 237-4, or a service business as 21 defined in this section;

22	areas in e	each county as enterprise zones for a period of twenty
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years. Any such area shall be located in one United States
 census tract or two or more contiguous United States census
 tracts in accordance with the most recent decennial United
 States Census. The census tract or tracts within which each
 enterprise zone is located also shall meet at least one of the
 following criteria:

7 (1) Twenty-five per cent or more of the population have
8 incomes below eighty per cent of the median family
9 income of the county; or

10 (2) The unemployment rate is 1.5 times the state average."
 11 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 12 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

13 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
