A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC UTILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, for farmers and 1 ranchers to remain competitive and self-sustaining, the State 2 must provide incentives and mechanisms to ensure that all means 3 of supporting the local agricultural industry are implemented. 4 The public utilities commission regulates the rates charged by 5 6 public utilities that provide essential services to the agriculture industry such as water, interisland shipping, and 7 8 electricity. The purpose of this Act is to provide for preferential 9 rates for public utility services provided to ratepayers engaged 10 in agricultural activities. 11 SECTION 2. Section 269-26.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 12 amended to read as follows: 13 "[+] §269-26.5[+] Preferential [water] rates for 14 agricultural activities. (a) It is the policy of the State to 15 promote the long-term viability of agriculture by establishing 16 mechanisms that provide for preferential rates for [potable 17 water for] public utility services that are provided to 18 HB LRB 09-1080.doc

<u>ratepayers that engage in agricultural activities</u>. The public
 utilities commission shall have the authority to establish
 preferential rates for [potable water] public utility services
 <u>that are used by ratepayers</u> for agricultural activities in a
 public utility's service area.

Upon receipt of a bona fide request for preferential 6 (b) 7 rates for [potable water] any public utility service to be used for agricultural activities [-7] on lands within an agricultural 8 district, and proof that the customer engages in agricultural 9 activities [-7] on lands within an agricultural district, a public 10 utility shall provide proposed preferential rates for [potable 11 water] the requested public utility service, including but not 12 limited to potable water, electricity, and freight transport, to 13 be used only for qualified agricultural activities subject to 14 the public utilities commission for approval. All such rates 15 approved by the public utilities commission shall be subsidized 16 by the [potable water] rates charged to other customers of the 17 public utility, if required, as determined by the public 18 utilities commission. In reviewing the proposed preferential 19 rates, the public utilities commission, in consultation with the 20 21 department of agriculture, may establish additional criteria to qualify bona fide agribusinesses for [water] public utility 22

3 commission shall allow the recovery of any reasonable
4 unamortized costs incurred by the public utility in its previous
