## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding two new sections to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	"§150A- Failure to pay or remit the inspection,
5	quarantine, and eradication service fee; fines. (a) The
6	following fines shall be imposed for failure to pay, bill, or
7	remit the inspection, quarantine, and eradication service fee as
8	provided for in section 150A-5.3:
9	(1) A person responsible for paying the freight charges to
10	the transportation company who does not pay the fee
11	shall be assessed a fine of \$250 for every one
12	thousand pounds of freight or part thereof; and
13	(2) A transportation company that does not:
14	(A) Bill the fee to the person responsible for paying
15	the freight charges to the transportation company
16	within fifteen days of the delivery of the
17	freight; or

1	(B) Remit the fee to the department within forty-five
2	days of collecting the fee from the person
3	responsible for paying the freight charges to the
4	transportation company,
5	shall pay a fine of \$250 for every one thousand pounds
6	of freight or part thereof.
7	(b) All fines shall be paid to the department and
8	deposited into the pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication
9	fund under section 150A-4.5.
10	§150A- Private cause of action. Any person may bring an
11	action in the appropriate court to enforce the provisions of
12	this chapter or énjoin the actions of a person in violation of
13	the provisions of this chapter. If the decree is for the
14	plaintiff, the plaintiff shall be awarded reasonable attorney's
15	fees together with the cost of suit."
16	SECTION 2. Section 150A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
17	amended by adding two new definitions to be appropriately
18	inserted and to read as follows:
19	"Cement bulk freight" means unpackaged, homogenous cement,
20	without mark or count and usually free-flowing, bought and sold
21	by weight or volume.

1	"Liquid bulk freight" means unpackaged, homogenous liquid
2	goods, without mark or count and usually free-flowing, bought
3	and sold by weight or volume, such as oil."
4	SECTION 3. Section 150A-5.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5	amended to read as follows:
6	"§150A-5.3 Inspection, quarantine, and eradication service
7	fee and charge. There is imposed a fee for the inspection,
8	quarantine, and eradication of invasive species contained in any
9	freight, including but not limited to marine commercial
10	container shipment, air freight, or any other means of
11	transporting freight, foreign or domestic, that is brought into
12	the State $[-]$ , except for liquid bulk freight and cement bulk
13	freight. The fee shall be paid by the person responsible for
14	paying the freight charges to the transportation company, who
15	shall collect the fee and forward the payment to the department
16	at the port of disembarkation; provided that the transportation
17	company shall not be liable for any fee that is not paid by the
18	person responsible for paying the freight charges to the
19	transportation company. The department shall deposit the fee
20	into the pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund under
21	section 150A-4.5.

The fee shall be assessed on the net weight of the imported 1 2 freight computed on the basis of 50 cents for every one thousand 3 pounds of freight brought into the State, or part thereof. The 4 fee shall be paid by the person responsible for paying the 5 freight charges to the transportation company, who shall collect the fee and forward the payment to the department at the port of 6 disembarkation; provided that the transportation company shall 7 8 not be liable for any fee that is not paid by the person 9 responsible for paying the freight charges to the transportation 10 company. The department shall deposit the fee into the pest inspection, guarantine, and eradication fund under section 150A-11 12 4.5.

13 The fee shall be assessed on the net weight of the imported 14 freight computed on the basis of 50 cents for every one thousand 15 pounds of freight brought into the State or part thereof."

16 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

18 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
