DEPARTMENT: Agriculture

TITLE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

PURPOSE: Requires nursery certification fees to be deposited into the pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund.

MEANS: Amend sections 150A-4.5(a) and 150A-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: Industry leaders have indicated that a higher certification fee is warranted in order to support funding for plant quarantine inspectors. This bill will allow nursery certification fees deposited into the pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication fund to be used for personnel and other costs incurred to provide the nursery certification services. The bill is submitted in anticipation of an industry initiative to raise fees. Timing of the initiative is unknown.

Impact on the public: None.

Impact on the department and other agencies: Increased flexibility to respond in the event of further cuts to general funds.

GENERAL FUND:

Potential reduction of general funded plant quarantine branch positions through future shift to special fund; reduction of funds returned to the general fund from the nursery certification fees(approximately \$15,000 annually is currently collected).
