TITLE:

A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE ACCESS HAWAII COMMITTEE.

PURPOSE: To establish the Access Hawaii Committee Special Fund that shall receive fees collected by the Information and Communication Services Division within the Department of Accounting and General Services from the portal contract.

MEANS: By adding a new section to chapter 27G, Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: By establishing a special fund, the Access Hawaii Committee will be able to exercise the provision in the contract that assesses the contractor a monthly fee to cover administrative and operational overhead costs. Without this special fund, there is no mechanism to collect fees.
