A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RENEWABLE ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to exempt certain
2	types of renewable energy projects from the general excise tax
3	for a period of five years to encourage the construction and
4	utilization of these types of systems.
5	SECTION 2. Chapter 237, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
6	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
7	and to read as follows:
8	"§237- Exemption of sale, installation, servicing, or
9	lease of renewable energy systems. (a) Beginning January 1,
10	2011, and expiring December 31, 2015, there shall be exempted
11	from the general excise tax imposed by this chapter the gross
12	proceeds arising from the sale, installation, servicing, and
13	leasing of a renewable energy system installed between January
14	1, 2011, and December 31, 2015.
15	(b) The department of business, economic development, and
16	tourism shall certify whether the renewable energy system meets
17	the requirements of this section. The department of business,
18	economic development, and tourism shall adopt rules pursuant to

1	chapter 91 to assess whether a renewable energy system qualifies
2	for the tax exemption under this section, including but not
3	limited to the following issues:
4	(1) The minimum construction and operating standards of a
5	renewable energy system required to qualify for the
6	exemption under this section; and
7	(2) Inspection and certification requirements.
8	(c) As used in this section "renewable energy system"
9	means a system that:
10	(1) Has a rated capacity of two megawatts of electrical
11	power; or
12	(2) Utilizes five hundred thousand or more gallons per
13	year of liquid fuel produced from one or more sources
14	of renewable energy, as that term is defined in
15	section 269-91, to generate electrical power.
16)	(d) The exemption shall not apply to gross proceeds
17	associated with the preparation of plans, designs, or permitting
18	associated with the renewable energy system."
19	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
20	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
