A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO NON-GENERAL FUNDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The severe recession of 2008 swept across the
nation and many parts of the world with unanticipated force and
brought with it enormous challenges for governments at all
levels. Its effects on businesses and employment are still
being felt today, which has had a profound impact on Hawaii in
terms of tax revenues and the state budget.

7 The legislature finds that due to the extraordinary fiscal 8 circumstances the State is facing, non-general funds must be 9 reviewed and scrutinized to determine if there are excess 10 balances available to help address the critical budget shortfall 11 in fiscal year 2009-2010.

12 The purpose of this Act is to help address the fiscal year 13 2009-2010 budget shortfall by transferring excess balances from 14 various non-general funds into the State's general fund.

15 SECTION 2. The legislature determines that there is in the 16 wireless enhanced 911 fund at least \$5,000,000 in excess of the 17 requirements of the fund. On June 1, 2010, the director of

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fund to the general fund the sum of \$\$ or so much thereof as
may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

3 SECTION 3. The legislature determines that there is in the 4 state motor pool revolving fund at least \$500,000 in excess of 5 the requirements of the fund. On June 1, 2010, the director of 6 finance is authorized to transfer from the state motor pool 7 revolving fund to the general fund the sum of \$ or so much 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

9 SECTION 4. The legislature determines that there is in the 10 state risk management revolving fund at least \$1,000,000 in 11 excess of the requirements of the fund. On June 1, 2010, the 12 director of finance is authorized to transfer from the state 13 risk management revolving fund to the general fund the sum of 14 \$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 15 2009-2010.

SECTION 5. The legislature determines that there is in the medicaid investigations recovery fund at least \$1,500,000 in excess of the requirements of the fund. On June 1, 2010, the director of finance is authorized to transfer from the medicaid investigations recovery fund to the general fund the sum of or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.



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SECTION 6. The legislature determines that there is in the
University of Hawaii housing assistance revolving fund at least
\$2,000,000 in excess of the requirements of the fund. On June
1, 2010, the director of finance is authorized to transfer from
the University of Hawaii housing assistance revolving fund to
the general fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof as may be
necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010.

8 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
