RELATING TO ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE PRODUCTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 302A-1509, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

5	of education shall require that all public school facilities		
6	give first preference, where feasible, to the purchase and use		
7	of environmentally-sensitive cleaning and maintenance products		
8	that have been <u>labeled as</u> approved by the [Green Scal program]		
9	Design for the Environment program of the United States		
10	Environmental Protection Agency [pursuant to section 321 26.5,		
11	for use in public school facilities]:		
12	(1) To clean hard surfaces in bathrooms such as counters,		
13	walls, floors, fixtures, basins, tubs, or tile;		
14	(2) To eliminate dirt and stains on rugs and carpeting;		
15	(3) For routine cleaning of hard surfaces, including		
16	impervious flooring such as concrete or tile; provided		
17	that this category shall not include:		

T		(A) Products intended primarity to strip, poinsh, or
2		wax floors; or
3		(B) Cleaners intended primarily for cleaning toilet
4		bowls, dishes, laundry, upholstery, or wood;
5	(4)	To clean glass, windows, mirrors, or metallic or
6		polished surfaces;
7	(5)	For routine, non-specialized hand cleaning;
8	(6)	Paper towels or other paper used for cleaning;
9		provided that this category shall not include toilet
10		paper, facial tissue, or paper towels used for drying
11		hands; and
12	(7)	Other categories as identified $[\frac{1}{2}]$ by the department
