A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that residents of the 2 State have historically enjoyed the shoreline and the ocean, 3 often accompanied by their pet dogs. As the demand for 4 shoreline resources has increased to accommodate more people, 5 new shoreline regulations have resulted in limiting shoreline 6 areas for residents with pet dogs. 7 The purpose of this Act is to set aside designated areas in 8 state parks along the shoreline to allow residents to enjoy 9 these areas with their pet dogs. SECTION 2. Chapter 184, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 10 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated 11 12 and to read as follows: 13 Dogs permitted in state parks. (a) Dogs shall "§184-14 be permitted in state parks, in designated areas that have 15 access to the shoreline; provided that: 16 The dog is under the control of a person by means of a (1) 17 leash, cord, chain, or other similar means of physical

1	(2) The leash, cord, chain, or other means of restraint is
2	not more than eight feet in length.
3	(b) The person in control of the dog shall be responsible
4	for the proper disposal of any fecal waste left by the dog in
5	the state park.
6	(c) For the purposes of this section, the term "state
7	parks" shall not include any area designated as a part of the
8	Hawaii natural area reserves system established under chapter
9	195.
10	(d) The State shall not be liable for any civil damages
11	for any injury to any person or any damage to any property
12	caused by any dog in a state park, unless the injury or damage
13	results from the gross negligence or wilful or wanton act or
14	omission by a state officer or employee.
15	(e) The department may adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91
16	to effectuate this section, including fines for violation of
17	this section; provided that no fine shall exceed \$."
18	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
19	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
