Passenger cars of any gross vehicle weight rating, (3) 9 buses designed to transport fifteen or fewer 10 occupants, and trucks and vans having a gross vehicle 11 weight rating of fifteen thousand pounds or less; and 12 All of the motor vehicles in category (3) and [trucks (4) 13 having a gross vehicle-weight-rating-of fifteen 14 thousand one through twenty six thousand pounds.] any 15 vehicle that is not a commercial motor vehicle. 16

17 A school bus or van operator shall be properly licensed to18 operate the category of vehicles that the operator operates as a
