- 1 SECTION 1. Section 291-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending the definition of "certificate of
- 3 disability" to read as follows:
- 4 ""Certificate of disability" means a medical statement
- 5 issued by a licensed practicing physician $[\tau]$ or a chiropractor
- 6 licensed under chapter 442, which verifies that a person is
- 7 disabled, limited, or impaired in the ability to walk."
- 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
