# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SOLID WASTE.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 342G-62, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) There is established a solid waste management
4	surcharge. The solid waste management surcharge shall be 35
5	cents per ton of solid waste <u>either</u> disposed of within the
6	[State] state at permitted or unpermitted solid waste disposal
7	facilities[-] and waste-to-energy facilities, or transferred to
8	solid waste reduction facilities within the state that collect
9	solid waste for transport to an out-of-state landfill,
10	incineration facility, or waste-to-energy facility.
11	The surcharge shall be paid by the person or entity doing
12	the disposal or the person or entity responsible for the
13	preparation for the out-of-state transfer of collected solid
14	waste. The owner or operator of the facility shall transfer all
15	moneys collected from the surcharge to the department through a
16	quarterly reporting and payment schedule. Estimates of
17	quarterly solid waste disposal shall be submitted prior to the

- 1 first day of each quarter and the transfer of moneys collected
- 2 shall occur within thirty days of the end of each quarter."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
