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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LOANS FOR HEALTH PROFESSIONALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SEC	TION 1. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to read as follows:		
4	" <u>§</u> 3:	21- Loans to health professionals; rural areas;	
5	rural are	ea health professionals loan fund. (a) The department	
6	of health	n shall establish a loan program to provide interest-	
7	free home	e purchase loans to qualified health professionals.	
8	(b)	Loans made under this section shall be interest-free	
9	and used	by the qualified health professional exclusively for	
10	the purch	ase of a home, including an apartment, townhouse, and	
11	condominium in the State. In addition, loans made under this		
12	section shall be:		
13	(1)	Repaid with a payment plan specified by the	
14		department; provided that additional payments in any	
15		sums, or the payment of the entire principal, may be	
16		made at any time within the term of the loan;	
17	(2)	Secured in a manner to be determined by the	
18		department; and	



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1	(3) Subject to penalties for delinquency or late payments		
2	as specified by the department, including penalties		
3	under subsection (c).		
4	The department shall negotiate the terms and conditions of each		
5	loan to ensure that each loan complies with this section.		
6	(c) If at any time during the term of a loan, a qualified		
7	health professional receiving the loan fails to comply with the		
8	requirements established in the definition of "qualified health		
9	professional" under this section, the loan shall be considered		
10	forfeited and all principal amounts outstanding, plus penalties,		
11	shall become due and payable. If the principal amount		
12	outstanding and penalties are not remitted, the department may		
13	initiate foreclosure proceedings on the home purchased through		
14	the proceeds from the loan. This subsection shall not apply in		
15	cases where the qualified health professional fails to comply		
16	with the requirements because of circumstances beyond the		
17	qualified health professional's control, as determined by the		
18	department.		
19	(d) Loans provided under this section shall not exceed		
20	\$ per qualified health professional. Each qualified		
21	health professional shall receive no more than one loan under		
22	this section.		
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1	(e) '	There is established in the state treasury a special	
2	fund to be known as the rural area health professionals loan		
3	fund. The fund shall be administered by the department pursuant		
4	to this section. The rural area health professionals loan fund		
5	shall be funded by:		
6	(1)	Legislative appropriations;	
7	(2)	Federal funds, if available; and	
8	(3)	All principal payments, fees, penalties, and any other	
9]	proceeds derived by the department pursuant to this	
10	-	section.	
11	(f)	For the purposes of this section:	
12	"Qualified health professional" means a licensed physician		
13	or an advanced practice registered nurse working at least forty		
14	hours per week in a qualified rural area health facility who		
15	fulfills the eligibility requirements, if any, specified under		
16	subsection (g).		
17	"Qualified rural health facility" means a public or private		
18	hospital,	medical clinic, or physician's office that:	
19	(1)	Has demonstrated difficulty in hiring and retaining	
20	:	licensed physicians or advanced practice registered	
21	2	nurses, according to standards and criteria specified	
22		by the department; and	
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1	(2) Is located in a rural area that is characterized by a		
2	low population density and the absence of "city-like"		
3	concentration of structures, streets, and urban		
4	services; provided that the department may establish		
5	more specific criteria and standards to further define		
6	"rural area".		
7	(g) The department shall adopt rules in accordance with		
8	chapter 91 to carry out the purpose of this section, including		
9	rules establishing eligibility requirements for health		
10	professionals applying for loans under this section."		
11	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
12	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so		
13	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and		
14	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal		
15	year 2010-2011 to be deposited into the rural area health		
16	professionals loan fund.		
17	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department		
18	of budget and finance for the purposes of this Act.		
19	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the rural area		
20	health professionals loan fund the sum of \$ or so much		
21	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the		
22	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
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2010-2011 to be used for the purposes of the rural area health
professionals loan fund.
The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
of health for the purposes of this Act.
SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
