BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 302A-404, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:
"§302A-404 School meals. (a) School meals shall be made
available under the school meals program in every school where
the students are required to eat meals at school.
(b) Each school drawing students from an area in which
taro farms are located, shall serve poi or other taro product
under the school meals program no less than once each week. To
the extent possible, the poi or taro product shall be purchased
from a taro farm located within the respective departmental
school district."
SECTION 2. Section 302A-431.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
"(b) The agriculture education program shall be
administered by a director who shall:
(1) Assist in assessing the agricultural needs of the
State and devise methods of meeting those needs with

the agriculture education program;
