RELATING TO THE BOATING SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the board of land
and natural resources is transferring funds out of the boating
special fund for purposes other than the repair, maintenance,
and capital improvements of boating facilities.

5 The purpose of this Act is to support the recreational 6 renaissance of the State's boating facilities by ensuring that 7 mooring fees and other fees associated with the use of the 8 harbors remain within the boating special fund and are used only 9 for the repair, maintenance, and capital improvements of 10 recreational harbors for a period of five years.

11 SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the 12 board of land and natural resources shall not transfer any funds 13 from the boating special fund under section 248-8, Hawaii 14 Revised Statutes, for purposes other than to reserve funds to 15 repair, maintain, and pay for capital improvements of the 16 State's boating facilities under the jurisdiction of the 17 department of land and natural resources.
