A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO REAL PROPERTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to enable the 2 counties to promptly track property ownership, encumbrances, 3 restrictions, uses, and sales prices of real property for the 4 purpose of determining real property tax assessments. This Act 5 requires the registrar of the bureau of conveyances to provide 6 the administrator of the real property assessment division of a 7 county, as agreed upon by memorandum of understanding among the 8 several counties, with an image and index of all instruments and 9 documents that have been recorded. With this information, the 10 real property assessment division administrator shall serve as a 11 central clearinghouse and provide copies of the images to the 12 real property assessment administrators of the other counties. 13 SECTION 2. Section 502-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 14 amended to read as follows: 15 "§502-26 Copies of instruments, certificates. (a) The registrar, when applied to, shall furnish an attested copy of 16 17 any instrument or document recorded in the registrar's office,

1	registrar may also issue nonattested portions of any instrument
2	or document recorded in the registrar's office. The registrar
3	may issue certificates of search or [incumbrance] <u>encumbrance</u>
4	when personnel is available for the making of the certificate.
5	(b) Within ten days after the end of each week, or as soon
6	thereafter as possible, the assistant registrar shall deliver or
7	forward by mail or by electronic transmission, and without
8	charge, an image and index of all instruments or documents
9	relating to land in all the counties that have been recorded in
10	the registrar's office during each week to the county designated
11	to act as a central clearinghouse in a memorandum of
12	understanding agreed upon by the counties. The real property
13	assessment administrator of the county designated to act as a
14	central clearinghouse shall provide copies of the images,
15	without charge, to the real property assessment administrators
16	of the other counties. The index shall include the following
17	for each instrument:
18	(1) Document number;
19	(2) Certificate number;
20	(3) Date of the filing;
21	(4) Type of document;

3	(c) The registrar and the real property assessment
4	administrator of the county designated to act as a central
5	clearinghouse may impose a charge, pursuant to rules adopted
6	under chapter 91, to provide images or other information to
7	parties other than the counties."

Description:

Requires the registrar of the bureau of conveyances to provide, within 10 days and free of charge, an image and index of all instruments that contain real property transactions each week to the administrator of the real property division of a county, to be agreed upon in a memorandum of understanding among the counties. Effective date 1/1/46. (SD1)
