SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to preserve the

 SECTION 2. Chapter 7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
 read as follows:
 <u>"§7- Piscary rights.</u> Notwithstanding any law to the

8 <u>state marine waters, as defined in section 188-22.5, shall be</u>
9 <u>preserved. For the purposes of this section "resident" means a</u>
10 <u>person who has resided in the State for at least three years.</u>"

12 <u>SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.</u>
