BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 184, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated	
3	and to read as follows:	
4	" <u>§184-</u> <u>Public meeting; park management contracts.</u> (a)	
5	This section shall apply to all requests for proposals issued by	
6	the department for contracts for the management of a state park	
7	or the management of any activity within a state park.	
8	(b) The department shall hold a public meeting prior to	
9	the issuance of a request for proposals for the purpose of	
10	obtaining community input on the department's intentions and	
11	goals in contracting for the services. The public meeting shall	
12	be held at the earliest practicable point in the development of	
13	the request for proposals, and in any event, no later than	
14	thirty days prior to the issuance of the request for proposals.	
15	(c) The department shall provide notice at least ten days	
16	prior to the public meeting, and the notice shall be published	
17	in a newspaper of general circulation in each county in which

3	(1)	The state park or parks affected by the contract;
4	(2)	The services intended to be covered by the contract to
