Section 132D-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows: 4 5 "§132D-17 Inconsistent county ordinances, rules. [Notwithstanding any-other law-to-the contrary,] Except as 6 7 provided in this chapter, including section 132D-10, no county shall enact ordinances or adopt any rules regulating fireworks 8 9 or articles pyrotechnic [- except as required in this chapter,] 10 that is inconsistent with or more restrictive than $[\tau]$ the provisions of this chapter. Any ordinances and rules regulating 11 12 fireworks or articles pyrotechnic that were enacted or adopted by a county before March 31, 1995, except those provisions which 13 are not inconsistent with, or more restrictive than those of 14 15 this chapter, are declared void." 16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 17 18 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 19
