2. By amending subsection (4) to read as follows:
"(4) Cruelty to animals in the second degree is a
misdemeanor [-]; provided that, in addition to any other penalty
imposed, a person convicted under subsection (1)(g) shall be
fined not less than:
(A) \$50 for a first offense; and
(B) \$200 for any subsequent offense."
SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
begun before its effective date.
SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on December 21,
2058.
