A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 711-1100, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows: 3 1. By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted 4 and to read: 5 ""Primary pet enclosure" means any kennel, cage, or structure used to restrict a pet animal to a limited amount of 6 7 space." 8 By amending the definitions of "necessary sustenance" 9 and "pet animal" to read: 10 ""Necessary sustenance" means care sufficient to preserve 11 the health and well-being of a pet animal, except for 12 emergencies or circumstances beyond the reasonable control of 13 the owner or caretaker of the pet animal, and includes [but is 14 not limited to] the following requirements: 15 Food of sufficient quantity and quality to allow for **16** normal growth or maintenance of body weight;
- 17 (2) Open or adequate access to water in sufficient
 18 quantity and quality to satisfy the animal's needs;
