9		provided that the drug to be dispensed is medical	
10		oxygen; or	
11	(3)	By a practitioner to an ultimate user[+] or if	
12		prescribed by a veterinarian licensed under chapter	
13		471 for an animal, to the owner of the animal;

15		(A) The practitioner shall inform the patient $[_{7}]$ or
