A BILL FOR AN ACT

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated		
3	and to read as follows:		
4	"§291C- Mobile electronic devices; prohibited. (a) No		
5	person shall operate a motor vehicle while using a mobile		
6	electronic device.		
7	(b) The use of a mobile electronic device for the sole		
8	purpose of making a "911" emergency communication shall be an		
9	affirmative defense to this section.		
10	(c) The following persons shall be exempt from the		
11	provisions of subsection (a):		
12	(1) Emergency responders using a mobile electronic device		
13	while in the performance and scope of their official		
14	<pre>duties;</pre>		
15	(2) Drivers using two-way radios while in the performance		
16	and scope of their work-related duties; and		

1	(3)	Drivers holding a valid amateur radio operator licens
2		issued by the Federal Communications Commission and
3		using a half-duplex two-way radio.
4	<u>(d)</u>	As used in this section:
5	"Eme	rgency responders" include firefighters, emergency
6	medical t	echnicians, mobile intensive care technicians, civil
7	defense w	orkers, police officers, and federal and state law
8	enforceme	nt officers.
9	"Mob	ile electronic device":
10	(1)	Means any handheld or other portable electronic
11		equipment capable of providing wireless or data
12		communication between two or more persons, or of
13		providing amusement, including but not limited to a
14		cellular phone, text messaging device, paging device,
15		personal digital assistant, laptop computer, video
16		game, or digital photographic device.
17	(2)	Does not include any audio equipment or any equipment
18		installed in a motor vehicle for the purpose of
19		providing navigation, emergency assistance to the
20		operator of the motor vehicle, or video entertainment
21		to the passengers in the rear seats of the motor
22		vehicle.
