A BILL FOR AN ACT

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X, SECTION 2, OF THE HAWAII CONSTITUTION, TO CHANGE THE BOARD OF EDUCATION TO AN APPOINTED BOARD.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to propose a
2	constitutional amendment to article X, section 2, of the
3	Constitution of the State of Hawaii to change the method of
4	selection of board of education members from election to
5	appointment by the governor, with the advice and consent of the
6	senate.
7	SECTION 2. Article X, section 2, of the Constitution of
8	the State of Hawaii is amended to read as follows:
9	"BOARD OF EDUCATION
10	Section 2. There shall be a board of education [composed
11	of members who shall be elected in a nonpartisan manner by
12	qualified-voters, as provided by law, from two at large school
13	board districts. The first school board district shall be
14	comprised of the island of Oahu and all other islands not
15	specifically enumerated. The second school board district shall
16	be comprised of the islands of Hawaii, Maui, Lanai, Molokai,
