A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FURLOUGHS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to clarify 2 collective bargaining issues by specifying that a "furlough" relates to an employee's wages and hours and constitutes a term 3 and condition of employment that is a core subject of collective 4 5 bargaining. 6 SECTION 2. Section 89-9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows: The employer and the exclusive representative shall 8 meet at reasonable times, including meetings sufficiently in 9 10 advance of the February 1 impasse date under section 89-11, and 11 shall negotiate in good faith with respect to wages, hours, the 12 amounts of contributions by the State and respective counties to 13 the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust fund or a 14 voluntary employees' beneficiary association trust to the extent 15 allowed in subsection (e), and other terms and conditions of 16 employment that are subject to collective bargaining and that 17 are to be embodied in a written agreement as specified in section 89-10, but the obligation does not compel either party 18

- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
