A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 448E-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended to read as follows:

3 "§448E-5 Minimum requirements. An applicant for licensing
4 pursuant to this chapter shall possess the following minimum
5 qualifications:

6	(1)	Journey worker electrician[. Every applicant to]: To
7		be eligible for the journey worker electrician
8		examination, an applicant shall be at least eighteen
9		years of age and shall provide satisfactory evidence
10		of [experience]:

11(A)Experience in residential or commercial wiring of12at least five years full-time or its equivalent,13but not less than 10,000 hours [of experience],14in the trade under the supervision of a journey15worker or supervising electrician[-]; and16(B)Satisfactory completion, accepted by Honolulu

18 electrical academic coursework;

11	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
12	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
13	begun before its effective date.
14	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
15	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
16	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2010.
