### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COMMISSION ON SALARIES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 26-56, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 2 3 The commission shall review and recommend an "(b) appropriate salary for the governor, lieutenant governor, 4 5 members of the legislature, justices and judges of all state 6 courts, administrative director of the courts, deputy 7 administrative director of the courts, administrative director 8 of the State or an equivalent position, and department heads or executive officers and the deputies or assistants to the 9 10 department heads of the departments of: 11 (1)Accounting and general services; 12 (2)Agriculture; 13 (3)The attorney general; 14 Budget and finance; (4)15 (5)Business, economic development, and tourism; 16 Commerce and consumer affairs; (6)17 (7)Defense; 18 (8)Hawaiian home lands; HB LRB 09-1063.doc

- 3 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:
- 4 "(a) The chief justice, with the approval of the supreme
- 5 court, shall appoint an administrative director of the courts to
- 6 assist the chief justice in directing the administration of the
- 7 judiciary. The administrative director shall be a resident of
- 8 the State for a continuous period of three years prior to the
- 9 administrative director's appointment, and shall be appointed
- 10 without regard to chapter 76 and shall serve at the pleasure of
- 11 the chief justice. The administrative director shall hold no
- 12 other office or employment. Effective July 1, 2004, the salary
- 13 of the administrative director shall be as last recommended by
- 14 the judicial salary commission. Effective July 1, [2007,] 2013,
- 15 and every six years thereafter, the salary shall be as last
- 16 recommended by the commission on salaries pursuant to section
- 17 26-56, unless disapproved by the legislature.
- 18 2. By amending subsection (c) to read:
- "(c) The administrative director, with the approval of the
- 20 chief justice, shall appoint a deputy administrative director of
- 21 the courts without regard to chapter 76 and such assistants as
- 22 may be necessary. The assistants shall be appointed without

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- 1 regard to chapter 76. Effective July 1, 2000, the salary of the
- 2 deputy administrative director shall be no greater than provided
- 3 in section 26-52(3) and shall be determined by the chief justice
- 4 based upon merit and other relevant factors. Effective July 1,
- 5 2004, the salary of the deputy administrative director shall be
- 6 as last recommended by the judicial salary commission.
- 7 Effective July 1, 2013, and every six years thereafter, the
- 8 salary shall be as last recommended by the commission on
- 9 salaries pursuant to section 26-56, unless disapproved by the
- 10 legislature. The administrative director shall be provided with
- 11 necessary office facilities."
- 12 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 13 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon ratification of
- 15 a constitutional amendment requiring the commission on salaries
- 16 to review and recommend salaries for the administrative director
- 17 of the courts and the deputy administrative director of the
- 18 courts.
