## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR COLLECTIVE BARGAINING COST ITEMS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Under section 89-9(e), Hawaii Revised Statutes, 1 2 negotiations between the exclusive representative and the 3 employer are permitted on the amounts that the State and the counties contribute under sections 87A-32 through 87A-37, Hawaii 4 Revised Statutes, toward the payment of health benefit plan 5 costs. The parties are not permitted to use the binding 6 7 arbitration process to resolve disputes relating to the employer contributions to the Hawaii employer-union health benefits trust 8 9 fund under part IV, chapter 87A, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 10 Because the parties were unable to resolve their differences 11 through negotiations, a determination pursuant to section 89-11(q), Hawaii Revised Statutes, on contributions for health 12 13 benefits must be made by the legislature.
