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A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Chapter 150A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
and to read as follows:
"§150A- Failure to pay or remit the inspection,
quarantine, and eradication service fee; fines. (a) The
following fines shall be imposed for failure to pay, collect, or
remit the inspection, quarantine, and eradication service fee
imposed by section 150A-5.3:
(1) A person responsible for paying the freight charges to
the transportation company who fails to pay the fee
shall be assessed a fine of 50 cents for every one
thousand pounds of freight or part thereof; and
(2) A transportation company that fails to:
(A) Collect the fee, within fifteen days of the
delivery of the freight, from the person
responsible for paying the freight charges to the
transportation company; or



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1	(B) Remit the fee to the department within forty-five
2	days of collecting the fee from the person
3	responsible for paying the freight charges to the
4	transportation company,
5	shall pay a fine of 50 cents for every one thousand
6	pounds of freight or part thereof.
7	(b) All fines shall be paid to the department and
8	deposited into the pest inspection, quarantine, and eradication
9	fund under section 150A-4.5."
10	SECTION 2. Section 150A-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11	amended by adding four new definitions to be appropriately
12	inserted and to read as follows:
13	""Aggregate bulk freight" means unpackaged, pre-processed
14	homogenous particulate material used in construction, without
15	mark or count and usually free-flowing, bought and sold by
16	weight or volume, such as clean sand, gravel, crushed stone,
17	slag, recycled concrete, and geosynthetic aggregates.
18	"Cement bulk freight" means unpackaged, homogenous cement,
19	without mark or count, that is usually free-flowing and bought
20	and sold by weight or volume.



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1	"Coal bulk freight" means unpackaged, homogenous coal,
2	without mark or count and usually free-flowing, bought and sold
3	by weight or volume, used as a fuel.
4	"Liquid bulk freight" means unpackaged, homogenous liquid
5	goods, without mark or count, that are usually free-flowing and
6	bought and sold by weight or volume, such as oil, or other
7	complex mixture of petroleum hydrocarbons, bituminous liquids
8	such as asphalt, gasoline, and fuel oils."
9	SECTION 3. Section 150A-5.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended to read as follows:
11	"§150A-5.3 Inspection, quarantine, and eradication service
12	fee and charge. There is imposed a fee for the inspection,
13	quarantine, and eradication of invasive species contained in any
14	freight, including but not limited to marine commercial
15	container shipment, air freight, or any other means of
16	transporting freight, foreign or domestic, that is brought into
17	the State[-], except for liquid, cement, coal, and aggregate
18	bulk freight. The fee shall be paid by the person responsible
19	for paying the freight charges to the transportation company,
20	who shall collect the fee and forward the payment to the
21	department at the port of disembarkation; provided that the
22	transportation company shall not be liable for any fee that is
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not paid by the person responsible for paying the freight
charges to the transportation company. The department shall
deposit the fee into the pest inspection, quarantine, and
eradication fund under section 150A-4.5.

5 The fee shall be assessed on the net weight of the imported 6 freight computed on the basis of 50 cents for every one thousand 7 pounds of freight brought into the State, or part thereof." 8 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

10 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
