## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TORT LIABILITY.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3	and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§663-</u> Limited liability for use of tangible personal
5	property without remuneration. (a) No civil liability or cause
6	of action shall arise from a person's allowing a nonprofit
7	organization to use the person's tangible personal property
8	without remuneration or expectation of remuneration, except for
9	such damages as may result from the person's gross negligence or
10	wanton acts or omissions. For purposes of this subsection,
11	"nonprofit organization" means an organization falling within
12	Section 501(c)(3) of the United States Internal Revenue Code.
13	(b) No civil liability or cause of action shall arise from
14	a person's allowing the use of the person's tangible personal
15	property for shelter by another person without remuneration or
16	expectation of remuneration, except for such damages as may
17	result from the person's gross negligence or wanton acts or
18	omissions."
