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### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOBILE MEDICAL CARE.

#### **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1 SECTION 1. In response to the recent increase in emissions 2 from Kilauea's newest vent at Halema'uma'u crater, a House 3 Special Committee on Vog Effects was created to bring together experts to examine the effects of vog on the people of the State 4 of Hawaii. The Committee held a series of fact-finding meetings 5 6 focusing on health and public safety, agriculture, and economic impacts and tourism. The serious lack of hospitals and health 7 8 centers in the southern portion of the island of Hawaii that is 9 heavily impacted by vog, leaves residents of the area with 10 little access to appropriate medical care. The most efficient 11 solution is to provide a mobile medical van to be stationed at 12 and assigned to the Kona community hospital.

13 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to provide 14 the people of the southern portion of the island of Hawaii with 15 increased access to suitable emergency and clinical medical 16 care.

17 SECTION 2. (a) The Kona community hospital shall acquire 18 a mobile medical van to be based at the Kona community hospital HB HMS 2009-1341

1	and shall	establish a mobile medical van program to provide
2	basic med	ical clinical services to the South Kona, Kaʻu, and
3	upper Puna areas of the county of Hawaii.	
4	(b)	The program shall:
5	(1)	Hire medical personnel to operate and staff the van;
6	(2)	Establish routes and services for the areas of South
7		Kona, Kaʻu, and upper Puna;
8	(3)	Work with the State's interagency task force and
9		Hawaii county fire department to make the van
10		available for situations requiring the van's service;
11		and
12	(4)	Work with the department of education to provide
13		medical services to the schools in the indicated
14		areas.
15	SECTION 3. There is authorized a federal fund ceiling	
16	increase of \$500,000 for the department of land and natural	
17	resources to accommodate federal funds received under the	
18	Homeland Security Grant Program.	
19	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the federal funds	
20	received under the Homeland Security Grant Program the sum of	
21	\$500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year	
22	2009-2010 for the purchase of a mobile medical van, including

necessary planning and equipment to provide medical care
services in South Kona, Ka'u, and upper Puna on the island of
Hawaii.

4 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department 5 of land and natural resources in coordination with the department of health for the purposes of this Act; provided that 6 7 no funds shall be expended until an agreement has been established with an appropriate funding agency, public or 8 9 private, to provide the Kona community hospital with funding to 10 continue the mobile medical van program for not less than an 11 additional two years.

12 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.

### Report Title:

Mobile Medical Van; Vog Health Care

### Description:

Authorizes the use of federal Homeland Security Grant Program funds to provide the people of the southern portion of the island of Hawaii with increased access to suitable emergency and clinical medical care.
