BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 40-53, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
3	"(b) All employees hired on or after July 1, 1998, shall
4	designate a financial institution account into which the State
5	is authorized to deposit the employee's pay. The comptroller
6	may waive the requirements of this section for any state
7	employee upon request by the head of the employing department
8	under [$\frac{\text{policies prescribed}}{\text{prescribed}}$] $\frac{\text{rules adopted}}{\text{adopted}}$ by the comptroller[$\frac{1}{2}$]
9	in accordance with chapter 91. The implementation of this
10	section shall not be subject to negotiation under chapter 89."
11	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
