BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 444-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended t	o read as follows:
3	"§44	4-2 Exemptions. This chapter shall not apply to:
4	(1)	Officers and employees of the United States, the
5		State, or any county while in the performance of their
6		governmental duties;
7	(2)	Any person acting as a receiver, trustee in
8		bankruptcy, personal representative, or any other
9		person acting under any order or authorization of any
10		court;
11	(3)	A person who sells or installs any finished products,
12		materials, or articles of merchandise that are not
13		actually fabricated into and do not become a permanent
14		fixed part of the structure, or to the construction,
15		alteration, improvement, or repair of personal
16		property;
17	(4)	Any project or operation for which the [aggregate]

contract price for labor[, materials, taxes, and all

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other items] is not more than [\$1,000.] \$1,600, 1 2 exclusive of materials, taxes, and all other items. 3 This exemption shall not apply in any case where [a]: 4 (A) A building permit is required regardless of the 5 aggregate contract price, nor where the 6 undertaking is only a part of a larger or major 7 project or operation, whether undertaken by the 8 same or a different contractor; or [in which a 9 division] 10 Division of the project or operation is made in (B) 11 contracts of amounts not more than [\$1,000]12 \$1,600 for the purpose of evading this chapter or 13 otherwise; 14 (5)A registered architect or professional engineer acting 15 solely in the person's professional capacity; 16 (6) Any person who engages in the activities regulated in 17 this chapter as an employee with wages as the person's 18 sole compensation; 19 (7)Owners or lessees of property who build or improve 20 residential, farm, industrial, or commercial buildings 21 or structures on property for their own use, or for 22 use by their grandparents, parents, siblings, or HB LRB 09-0621-1.doc

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1 children and who do not offer the buildings or 2 structures for sale or lease; provided that this 3 exemption shall not apply to electrical or plumbing 4 work that must be performed only by persons or entities licensed under this chapter, or to the owner 5 or lessee of the property if the owner or lessee is 6 7 licensed under chapter 448E. In all actions brought 8 under this paragraph, proof of the sale or lease, or offering for sale or lease, of the structure not more 9 10 than one year after completion is prima facie evidence 11 that the construction or improvement of the structure 12 was undertaken for the purpose of sale or lease; 13 provided that this provision shall not apply to 14 residential properties sold or leased to employees of 15 the owner or lessee; provided further that in order to 16 qualify for this exemption the owner or lessee must 17 register for the exemptions as provided in section 18 444-9.1. Any owner or lessee of property found to 19 have violated this paragraph shall not be permitted to 20 engage in any activities pursuant to this paragraph or 21 to register under section 444-9.1 for a period of 22 three years. There is a presumption that an owner or

2		lessee obtains an exemption from the licensing
3		requirements of section 444-9 more than once in two
4		years;
5	(8)	Any joint venture if all members thereof hold licenses
6		issued under this chapter;
7	(9)	Any project or operation where it is determined by the
8		board that less than ten persons are qualified to
9		perform the work in question and that the work does
10		not pose a potential danger to public health, safety,
11		and welfare; or
12	(10)	Any public works project that requires additional
13		qualifications beyond those established by the
14		licensing law and which is deemed necessary and in the
15		public interest by the contracting agency."
