8	(1)	Provide for the reporting of energy efficiency
9		information on a subject property to consumers at the
10		time of sale or lease of that property after a certain
11		date;
12	(2)	Develop and provide information to banks, financial
13		institutions, mortgage lenders, and mortgage brokers
14		on the economics of energy efficient properties,
15		including savings over the life cycle of a property;
16		and
17	(3)	Establish a database of information on energy
18		efficiency that is available to realtors online.

1	(b) A report provided to a consumer pursuant to subsection		
2	(a)(1) shall also be provided to the new occupant of the		
3	property and the lender on the property prior to the lease or		
4	sale of the property.		
5	(c) The public utilities commission shall adopt rules,

7	section."
