BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 121-45, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a) The adjutant general, subject to the availability of
4	funds, may award tuition assistance to qualified enlisted
5	persons, warrant officers, and [company grade] commissioned and
6	general officers $[(0-1 \text{ through } 0-3)]$ in the Hawaii national
7	guard who are:
8	(1) Residents of the State, as defined by the board of
9	regents pursuant to section [+]304A-402[+]; and
10	(2) [Undergraduate students] <u>Students</u> working toward a
11	degree on any campus of the University of Hawaii."
12	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
13	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
14	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and
15	the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal
16	year 2010-2011 to provide tuition assistance to members of the
17	Hawaii national guard who are students working toward a degree
18	on any campus of the University of Hawaii system. HB LRB 09-0995.doc
