A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTION DAY VOTER REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended		
2	by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to		
3	read as follows:		
4	" <u>§11-</u> Election day registration. (a) Persons seeking		
5	to vote on primary, special primary, special, general, or		
6	special general election day may register on that election day		
7	by appearing during the hours of voting in person at the polling		
8	place for the precinct in which the person maintains residence,		
9	by completing an application to register pursuant to section 11-		
10	15, making an oath in the form prescribed by the chief election		
11	officer, providing proof of identity, and providing proof of		
12	residence.		
13	(b) Proof of identity may be provided by one of the		
14	following:		
15	(1) A valid United States passport;		
16	(2) A valid Hawaii driver's license;		
17	(3) A Hawaii civil identification certificate issued		
18	pursuant to section 846-30; or		

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1	(4)	A valid identification card issued by any component of
2		the military.
3	(C)	Proof of residency may be provided by one of the
4	following	<u> :</u>
5	(1)	A valid Hawaii driver's license;
6	(2)	A Hawaii civil identification certificate issued
7		pursuant to section 846-30;
8	(3)	A utility bill showing the voter's current home
9		address;
10	(4)	A bank statement, credit union statement, credit card
11		statement, or brokerage account statement showing the
12		voter's current home address; or
13	(5)	A valid student identification that:
14		(A) Shows proof of having met the requirements of
15		section 304A-402; and
16		(B) Contains a photograph of the person identified;
17	provided	that the document used to establish identity pursuant
18	to subsec	tion (b) shall not also be used to establish residency
19	pursuant	to subsection (c).
20	(d)	Nothing in this section shall allow a person to avoid
21	fulfillin	g any requirements of registration pursuant to section
22	<u>11-15.</u> "	
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SECTION 2. Section 11-24, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended by amending the title and subsections (a) and (b) to
read as follows:

4 "§11-24 [Closing register;] Registration before election 5 day; list of voters. (a) At 4:30 p.m. on the thirtieth day 6 prior to each primary, special primary, or special election (but 7 if the day is a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday then at 4:30 p.m. 8 on the first working day immediately thereafter), the general 9 county register shall be closed to registration for persons 10 seeking to vote at the primary, special primary or special 11 election and remain closed to registration until after the 12 election, subject to change only as provided in sections 11-13 21(c), 11-22, 11-25, 11-26, 11-, and this section.

14 (b) Notwithstanding the closing of the register for 15 registration before election day to vote at the primary or 16 special primary election, the register shall remain open for the 17 registration of persons seeking to vote at the general or 18 special general election, until 4:30 p.m. on the thirtieth day 19 prior to the general or special general election (but if the day 20 is a Saturday, Sunday, or holiday then at 4:30 p.m. on the first 21 working day immediately thereafter), at the end of which period 22 the general county register shall be closed to registration and



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1	remain closed until after the general or special general			
2	election next following, subject to change only as provided in			
3	sections 11-21(c), 11-22, 11-25, [and] 11-26[-], and 11"			
4	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general			
5	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so			
6	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 for			
7	developing an election day voter day registration system.			
8	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the office of			
9	elections for the purposes of this Act.			
10	SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed			
11	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.			
12	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2009.
