RELATING TO FISCAL NOTES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to read
as follows:
" <u>§</u> -A Fiscal notes on legislative bills. (a) Beginning
with the 2007 regular session of the legislature, when a bill is
reported from the final committee to which the bill has been
referred prior to passage on third reading in either house of
the legislature, there shall be attached to the bill a fiscal
note as provided in subsection (b), or, if the bill has no
fiscal impact, a statement to that effect.
(b) Fiscal notes shall be prepared in conformity with the
requirements of this section by the committee specified in
subsection (a), which may request the assistance of the
legislative analyst, as well as any affected state departments
or agencies in preparing the fiscal note.
(c) The fiscal note shall contain the following
information:
