1	SECT	ION 1. Section 281-78, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	No person shall possess any open liquor container or
4	consume a	ny liquor on any:
5	(1)	Public highway, except as permitted in section
6		291-3.4;
7	(2)	Public sidewalk, including any sidewalk within a
8		public housing project as defined in section 356D-1 or
9		356D-91; or
10	(3)	Common area of a public housing project as defined in
11		section 356D-1 or 356D-91. For purposes of this
12		paragraph, "common area" means roofs, halls,
13		corridors, lobbies, stairs, stairways, fire escapes,
14		entrances and [+]exits[+] of the building or
15		buildings, basements, yards, gardens, recreational
16		facilities, parking areas, storage spaces, and other
17		parts of the project normally in common use or other

1	areas designated by the Hawaii public housing
2	authority.
3	For the purposes of paragraphs (2) and (3), possessing an
4	open liquor container shall be prima facie evidence that a
5	person is consuming liquor."
6	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
7	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
8	begun, before its effective date.
9	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
10	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
11	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2010.
