A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE WORKS OF ART SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- SECTION 1. Section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 2 amended as follows: 3 1. By amending subsections (a), (b), and (c) to read: There is created a works of art special fund, into 4 5 which shall be transferred [one] two per cent of all state fund 6 appropriations for capital improvements designated for the 7 construction cost element; provided that this transfer shall 8 apply only to capital improvement appropriations that are 9 designated for the construction or renovation of state 10 buildings. The [one] two per cent transfer requirement shall 11 not apply to appropriations from the passenger facility charge special fund established by section 261-5.5 and the rental motor 12 vehicle customer facility charge special fund established under 13 14 section 261-5.6.
- (b) The works of art special fund shall be used solely for the following purposes:

Works of Art Special Fund

Description:

Increases the amount of state fund appropriations for capital improvement construction costs earmarked for the Works of Art Special Fund (Special Fund) from one to two percent. Allows 50 percent of the Special Fund to be used for capital improvement projects, the purchase of facilities, and repair and maintenance of facilities dedicated to culture and the arts. (HB601 HD1)
