A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CERTIFICATES OF NEED.

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. (a) There shall be established a twelve-member		
2	certificate of need study blue ribbon panel. The members shall		
3	include the director of health and eleven members of the public.		
4	The public members shall be appointed as follows:		
5	(1) Three persons shall be appointed by the president of		
6	the senate, of whom:		
7	(A) One shall be a licensed health care professional;		
8	(B) One shall be a representative of a licensed		
9	health care facility; and		
10	(C) One shall have knowledge about health care		
11	financing;		
12	(2) Three persons shall be appointed by the speaker of the		
13	house of representatives, of whom:		
14	(A) One shall be a licensed health care professional;		
15	(B) One shall be a representative of a licensed		
16	health care facility; and		
17	(C) One shall have knowledge about health care		
18	financing; and		
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1	(3)	Five persons shall be appointed by the governor, of	
2		whom:	
3		(A) One shall be a licensed health care professional;	
4		(B) One shall be a representative of a licensed	
5		health care facility; and	
6		(C) Three shall have knowledge about health care	
7		financing.	
8	Vacancies	in the membership of the panel shall be filled in the	
9	same manno	er provided for the original appointments. The	
10	appointme	nt of panel members shall not be subject to senate	
11	confirmat	lon.	
12	(b)	The membership of the panel shall vote to elect a	
13	chairperson.		
14	(c)	The panel shall be entitled to request assistance and	
15	informatio	on from the employees of any county or state executive	
16	department	, board, bureau, commission, or agency as may be	
17	required :	or its purposes. The department of health shall	
18	provide ad	aministrative, professional, technical, and clerical	
19	staff supp	port for the panel.	
20	(d)	The panel shall conduct a comprehensive study to

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1	(1)	Certificate of need processes in other states that
2		have been modified or eliminated, and the effects of
3	1	the modifications or elimination;
4	(2)	What other states are doing to reform the certificate
5		of need process; and
6	(3)	The impact that modification or elimination of the
7		certificate of need process may have on the state with
8		regard to:
9		(A) Access to care by residents;
10		(B) Quality of care;
11		(C) Services that are delivered statewide or on a
12		regional basis; and
13		(D) Funding, including programs such as medicaid.
14	(e)	The panel shall submit a report to the legislature no
15	later than	n twenty days prior to the convening of the regular
16	session or	f 2010. The report shall include recommendations,
17	including	suggested legislation, if any, on:
18	(1)	The panel's findings with regard to other states'
19		experiences with the certificate of need process;
20	(2)	The future of Hawaii's certificate of need process;



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(3) Which health care services or facilities, if any,
should continue to be subject to the certificate of
need requirements or other state regulation; and
(4) Which services or facilities should be exempt from
state regulation.
SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
