A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO REMOTE DISPENSING PHARMACIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many individuals 1 living in underserved or remote areas need improved access to 2 3 medications and pharmacy services. Access to medications and pharmacy services is also critical for individuals who are 4 privately insured and who reside on islands where there are no 5 pharmacies. Without access to an on-island pharmacy, 6 7 individuals face tremendous barriers to obtaining basic, muchneeded medications. 8 The purpose of this Act is to permit residents on islands 9 10 where there are no pharmacies to have access to a remote 11 dispensing pharmacy for the purpose of obtaining medications 12 regardless of the type of medical insurance they may have. SECTION 2. Section 461-10.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 13 14 amended as follows: 15 1. By amending subsections (c) and (d) to read as follows:

16 "(c) No remote dispensing pharmacy shall operate within a 17 five mile radius of any pharmacy as defined under section 461-1; 18 provided that:

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This subsection shall not apply to [any]: 1 (1)Any remote dispensing pharmacy established prior 2 (A) to July 3, 2008, that has previously dispensed 3 and will continue to dispense only prescription 4 medications acquired pursuant to section 340B of 5 the Public Health Service Act, Title 42 United 6 States Code section 256b[; and]; or 7 Any remote dispensing pharmacy located on an 8 (B) island that did not have a pharmacy at the time 9 the remote dispensing pharmacy was established. 10 Such remote dispensing pharmacies may continue to 11 operate in the same location if a pharmacy is 12 subsequently established on the same island as 13 the remote dispensing pharmacy; and 14 If an appropriately designated pharmacy, as defined in (2)15 section 461-1, is established within a five mile 16 radius of an existing remote dispensing pharmacy 17 exempted by [this subsection,] paragraph (1)(A), all 18 appropriate measures shall be taken to encourage the 19 relocation of the existing remote dispensing machine 20 within the newly established pharmacy. 21

11	2.	By amending subsection (j) to read as follows:	
12	"(j)	Controlled substances shall not be dispensed from any	
13	remote di	spensing machine or remote dispensing pharmacy[-];	
14	provided	that:	
15	(1)	A remote dispensing pharmacy established on an island	
16		without a pharmacy may dispense controlled substances;	
17		and	
18	(2)	Upon the establishment of a pharmacy on the same	
19		island where a remote dispensing pharmacy is	
20		dispensing controlled substances under paragraph (1),	
21		no remote dispensing pharmacy on that island shall be	
22		authorized to dispense controlled substances."	
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SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.

Remote Dispensing Pharmacy; Better Access to Medications

Description:

Allows remote dispensing pharmacies operating on islands without a pharmacy to: 1) provide medications to patients with any health insurance; 2) dispense controlled substances under certain conditions; and 3) continue operating after a pharmacy is later established on the same island. Effective 7/1/2020. (HB655 HD2)
