H.B. NO. 698

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH CARE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this Act is to make health
 insurance temporarily available to individuals who become
 uninsured due to the loss of a job for reasons other than
 voluntary separation, discharge for work-related misconduct, or
 work stoppage caused by a labor dispute.

SECTION 2. (a) There is established the Hawaii health 6 7 care program as a temporary three-year pilot program to provide 8 health care coverage to certain individuals who became uninsured 9 due to the loss of a job. The department of human services 10 shall provide health care coverage through a public-private 11 partnership, established as a contract to provide health and 12 human services pursuant to chapter 103F, Hawaii Revised 13 Statutes, between the department and one or more managed care 14 plans operating in the state under chapter 432, Hawaii Revised 15 Statutes, that offers accident and health or sickness insurance 16 plans.

17 (b) It is not the intent of the legislature to discourage
18 employers from offering to pay, or from paying for, dependent
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1	coverage	for their employees, or that this Act supplant
2	employer-	sponsored dependent coverage plans.
3	(c)	To qualify for health coverage under this Act, an
4	individua	l shall:
5	(1)	Be at least eighteen years of age;
6	(2)	Be a Hawaii resident;
7	(3)	Have been uninsured continuously for at least six
8		months due to the loss of a job, for reasons other
9		than voluntary separation, discharge for work-related
10		misconduct, or work stoppage caused by a labor
11		dispute; and
12	(4)	During the six months the individual was uninsured,
13		have been ineligible for any other state or federal
14		health care coverage and be currently ineligible for
15		any other state or federal health care coverage.
16	(d)	Coverage received based upon satisfaction of the
17	eligibili	ty requirements of this Act shall continue until the
18	earlier of the following:	
19	(1)	The individual becomes employed and covered by a
20		prepaid health care plan; or



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1	(2) The expiration of six months following the		
2	commencement of health care coverage for the		
3	individual under this Act.		
4	(e) The department of human services and the managed care		
5	plans participating in the pilot program shall share equally in		
6	the cost of the premium for each individual enrolled in the		
7	program subject to the appropriation of general funds for the		
8	program.		
9	(f) The department of human services shall pay the State's		
10	share of the premiums under the program on a quarterly basis.		
11	(g) The managed care plans participating in the pilot		
12	program shall be responsible for determining the eligibility of		
13	program applicants and of enrolling applicants in the pilot		
14	program.		
15	(h) The managed care plans participating in the program		
16	shall provide to the department of human services and the		
17	legislature a quarterly report including the number of program		
18	enrollees.		
19	(i) The department of human services shall ensure that		
20	other private organizations have the opportunity to partner with		
21	the State to offer coverage to uninsured individuals under the		
22	program; provided that plan benefits to be provided shall be		



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1	equal to or better than those offered through the program		
2	established by the State and managed care plans under subsection		
3	(a).		
4	(j) The department of human services and any participating		
5	managed care plan shall report to the legislature no later than		
6	twenty days prior to the start of the 2010 and 2011 regular		
7	sessions on the pilot program, including:		
8	(1) Any problems encountered in the administration of the		
9	program;		
10	(2) The amount of funding used and for what purposes; and		
11	(3) Any proposed legislation.		
12	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
13	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much		
14	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2009-2010 and the		
15	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
16	2010-2011 to fund the Hawaii health care program established by		
17	this Act.		
18	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department		
19	of human services for the purposes of this Act.		
20	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval;		
21	provided that:		



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1	(1)	Section 3 of this Act shall take effect on July 1,
2		2009; and
3	(2)	This Act shall be repealed on June 30, 2012.
